About Deerfield-Windsor

Founded in 1964, Deerfield-Windsor School is an independent, coeducational, college preparatory day school enrolling students in pre-kindergarten through grade 12 on two campuses in Southwest Georgia. DWS's Nottingham Campus includes our Middle School with grades 6 thru 8 and Upper School with grades 9 thru 12. The Nottingham Campus has an enrollment of approximately 378 students including the Class of 2019 with 60 students.

Admission to Deerfield-Windsor is selective and based on applicant's academic record, admission testing scores, writing sample, and teacher recommendations. Currently, our student population consists of 10% ethnic minorities. For the 2018-19 school year, more than \$800,000 in tuition assistance was awarded to 20% of the students. Each Upper School student is required to complete 55 hours of community service. Historically, 100% of DWS graduates are accepted into colleges or universities.

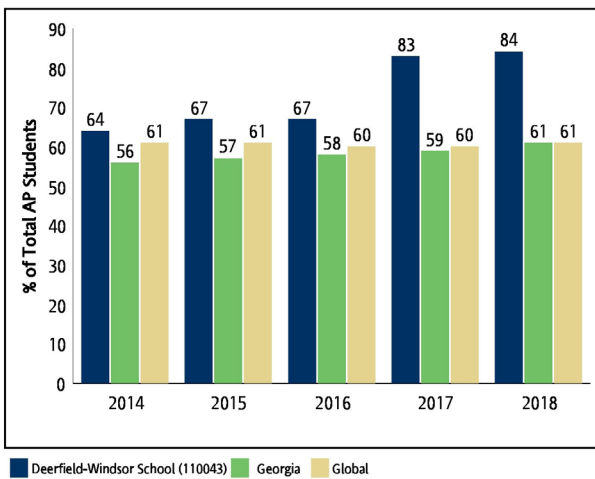
