### Registration Fees and Discounts

**Registration Fee:**

**For returning families:** Registration Fee is \$325 for first child; \$225 for each additional child. **The registration fee increases by \$300 per child if reenrollment occurs after February 28.**

**For new students:** Registration Fee is \$325 for first child; \$225 for each additional child.

**Early Payment Discount:**

**Annual payments:** Five percent (5%) discount is reflected above.

**Semi-Annual payments:** Two and one-half percent (2 ½ %) discount is reflected above.

**Building Fund Fee** – The Building Fund fee of \$1,000.00 is a one-time fee per new family. **The Building Fund fee can be paid in one lump sum or paid annually at \$250.00 for four years.** This charge will appear on your September student billing statement. If a family leaves Deerfield-Windsor School and returns within 3 years, no additional Building Fund fee will be applied. If a family returns after 3 or more years an additional Building Fund fee will be assessed.

**Book Charges** – Middle and Upper School students purchase their own textbooks and workbooks.

**Parent Association Dues** - \$25.00 per family will be assessed for Parent Association dues. The charge will appear on the September student billing statement.

**Re-Enrollment** - If a family is in arrears for any current or former student, they are considered delinquent for all students in the family and must settle their account before any students can re-enroll.

**Past Due Accounts:**

If payment on your student billing account is not received by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month, your account is considered past due and a finance charge of one and one-half percent (1½%) will be charged.

Deerfield-Windsor School reserves the right to withdraw a student from active enrollment at the school if the student's financial account is 60 days or more past due. In making a decision whether to withdraw a student from active enrollment under this provision, Deerfield-Windsor School is entitled to exercise unfettered discretion on a case-by-case basis, and Deerfield-Windsor School's failure to exercise its right to withdraw a student from active enrollment under this provision will not act as a waiver of Deerfield-Windsor School's rights or a release of any of the student's obligations hereunder. *Upon payment of the past due amount, the student will be allowed to return to active enrollment.* Further, if the delinquency occurs in the last semester of the year, no diploma or transcripts of credits will be released until all accounts are paid in full.

**Accounts Sent to Collection:**

If a Deerfield-Windsor School family's account is sent to collection and the family wishes to continue to attend school, the collection agency has to be paid in full. The family must pay the registration fee and a reinstatement fee before their child(ren) is/are allowed to re-enroll.

**School** - Deerfield-Windsor School is an independent college preparatory school for grades pre-kindergarten through twelve. The school is operated by a Board of Trustees according to the by-laws of United Parents, Inc., a nonprofit, tax-exempt corporation.

**Admission** - Admission is based upon good character, evidence of both ability and the desire to achieve at the level required by the school's college preparatory curriculum, and a willingness to live within the framework of school policy and regulations. Deerfield-Windsor School admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It is school policy, however, that, to be admitted, an applicant must be in good standing in his last school with a record of no serious disciplinary problems. Deerfield-Windsor School is authorized under Federal law to enroll non-immigrant alien students.

**Dismissal** - Deerfield-Windsor School reserves the right to dismiss any student at any time if it is determined in the discretion of the Headmaster that the student's conduct record or academic record at the school is not in keeping with the best interests of the school and its students.

**Publication** – Deerfield-Windsor School from time to time may take photographs of its students and faculty for publication in newspapers, newsletters, websites, or other print and electronic media. By enrolling a child in the school, each parent consents to having the student's photograph taken, published, and authorizes Deerfield-Windsor School to release the photo to others for non-commercial purposes.
